On January 28th, we had JA Inspire Osceola at Osceola Heritage Park welcoming more than 3,400 students to an interactive career exploration event. JA Inspire is a powerful initiative designed to bridge the gap between education and industry, giving students direct exposure to high-demand careers in Central Florida. Through handson experiences and conversations with business leaders, students gain insights into potential career paths, understand the skills required for success, and start shaping their futures.

Looking ahead, we are gearing up for JA Inspire Orange County, which will take place April 2-4 at the Orange County Convention Center. This event will bring together over 15,000 eighth-grade students, making it our largest career exploration event yet. We invite businesses, educators, and community leaders to join us in shaping the workforce of tomorrow by sponsoring, exhibiting, or volunteering at this impactful event.

In addition to Inspire, we continue to expand3DE by Junior Achievement, an innovative high school model that transforms education by integrating real-world case challenges into core learning. This approach not only increases student engagement but also enhances critical thinking and problem-solving skills. Next school year we will be expanding to include our 4-year program at Edgewater, Lake Buena Vista, Horizon, and Celebration High Schools. We will be hosting upcoming 3DE school tours, providing an opportunity for community partners to see firsthand how this program is shaping future leaders. 
