The Dreamers Center represents a place where students are encouraged to think beyond limits and truly believe in their potential. I was deeply inspired by the late Pat Williams, co-founder of the Orlando Magic and a visionary leader whose dreams helped shape this city, and I'm proud to honor his legacy through the Dreamers name."

Complementing this visionary gift, the Lewis Foundation and Lake Nona have generously committed to providing a home for the JA Eisner Family Dreamers Center within the Lake Nona Town Center. Their support includes making an existing facility available for JA BizTown®, centrally located within walking distance of the Wave Hotel and Lake Nona Performance Club.
